

## TEMPORARY CANNABIS CULTIVATION LICENSE EXTENSIONS

The California Department of Food and Agriculture's CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing Division may issue 90-day extensions for valid temporary cannabis cultivation licenses **only if a completed annual license application has been submitted prior to the temporary license's expiration date**, in accordance with section 26050.1 of the Business and Professions Code. It is the responsibility of the temporary license holder to ensure an annual cannabis cultivation license application has been completed and submitted in a timely manner to qualify for a temporary license extension.

### Annual Application Requirements

A completed annual cannabis cultivation license application must include the following:

1. All applicable requirements listed in section 8102 of the California Department of Food and Agriculture's cannabis cultivation program regulations. (To review the regulations, please visit the CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing website: [cannabis.cdca.ca.gov](http://cannabis.cdca.ca.gov).)
2. The applicable annual license application fee must be paid in full.

### Paper Annual Applications

If you are providing a paper application for an annual license less than two weeks before your temporary license expires, it may not provide adequate time for staff to enter all the information into the licensing system, process the application fee, and determine whether you qualify for a temporary license extension. Incomplete applications will be returned by mail to the Designated Responsible Party.

### Annual Application Fees

The annual application fee must be paid in full and the payment must be processed before an application will be considered complete. Electronic payments made online, such as with a credit or debit card or an e-check, are processed immediately upon approval. Cash payments may be delivered to a Bureau of Cannabis Control office in either Rancho Cordova or Eureka by appointment only; to make an appointment, please call toll-free 1-833-287-8171 or send an email to: [CannabisFeeAppt@dca.ca.gov](mailto:CannabisFeeAppt@dca.ca.gov). All other payment options can take 10 business days or longer to process. An application is not considered complete until the payment has been processed.
